YEAR 2	<p>Enquiry Question: Why did the fire in London spread so far?</p> <p>Great Fire of London</p> <p>Significant national event beyond living memory.</p> <p>Remembrance- Poppies on Flanders Field</p>	<p>Enquiry Question: Was the sinking of the Titanic a triumph or a tragedy?</p> <p>Sinking of the Titanic</p> <p>Local/national/international event which started global safety changes.</p>	<p>Enquiry Question: Who was more significant, Florence Nightingale or Mary Seacole?</p> <p>Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole</p> <p>(Linked to School Christian Value of Love)</p> <p>Significant individuals who have contributed to national and international achievements.</p>
