What we already know:

• Identify Loud, moderate, quiet and silence.

Explore, use, respond to and recognise fast, moderate and slow.

How to chant and sing rhymes to show character or build mood.

Key Vocabulary

How sounds are produced: Tap, Shake, Scrape

<u>Dynamics:</u> Loud, quiet <u>Tempo:</u> Fast and slow

Pitch: High, low

Duration: Long, Short, beat, rhythm, start, stop

Rhythm: Steady beat **Instrument Names:**

Untuned percussion- triangle, maraca, guiro, cabassa, tambourine, wood block, drums, cymbals, bells, egg

shakers, claves, indian bells

Tuned percussion- glockenspiel, xylophone, chime bar
